Volunteer Rights and Responsibilities

Volunteer Rights:

- · Receive clear information regarding the volunteer selection process.
- Engage in meaningful contribution and relevant tasks.
- · Have a clear understanding of their role.
- Receive appropriate training and guidance.
- Be recognised and appreciated for their contributions.
- · Access necessary support and assistance when needed.
- Develop new skills and grow personally and professionally.
- Make mistakes and learn from them in a supportive environment.
- · Know whom to approach in case of concerns or issues.
- · Receive reimbursement for approved expenses.
- Be informed about the disciplinary and grievance procedures.
- · Receive attitude free from discrimination with equal treatment for all.
- · Work in safe and secure working environment.
- Be kept informed about and have the opportunity to engage in the organisation's activities.
- Decline a task by providing a reasonable explanation, NO is also an answer.

Volunteer Responsibilities:

- · Uphold the organisation's mission and values.
- Demonstrate commitment.
- Prove reliability by informing promptly of any delays or inability to attend.
- Maintain punctuality.
- Participate in required training sessions and meetings.
- Perform tasks with a high standard of quality.
- · Communicate openly about any difficulties or concerns they may encounter.
- · Uphold confidentiality and act with integrity.
- Respectfully conclude their volunteer engagement when requested by the programme coordinator
 or if they no longer find the experience fulfilling.

Volunteer Roles and Tasks

Information and Hospitality

- Providing assistance and guidance to visitors at events and public spaces.
- Supporting operations at the "Liepāja 2027" information point.
- Assisting individuals with disabilities, including visual, hearing, mobility, and cognitive impairments.
- · Welcoming and directing both local and international guests to designated locations.

Event Support

- · Assisting with event setup and breakdown.
- Managing entrance and ticket control.
- Providing cloakroom services.
- Ensuring smooth crowd flow and monitoring safety measures.
- · Supporting food and beverage services.
- · Offering backstage assistance.
- · Coordinating traffic flow at event venues.



Team Leadership

- · Coordinating volunteers.
- · Providing support, motivation, and inspiration.
- · Resolving on-site challenges.
- · Reporting key insights and updates.

Culture Buddy

A Culture Buddy is more than a local guide, they are bridges between worlds, helping newcomers tap to Liepāja's rhythm, traditions, and everyday life. - Introduce visitors to the cultural gems of Liepāja and the region.
- Open your home or hobby space for an authentic, one-of-a-kind experience.

Communication and Marketing

- · Craft engaging social media content.
- Spread the word about Liepāja 2027 through promotional materials.
- · Share the stories of volunteers.

First Aid

• Provide first aid at events (for volunteers with the appropriate certification).


Volunteers must be at least 13 years old when taking on their first assignment.
